

Many men left their farms and businesses to quench the flames engulfing structures when fires arose from wood

burning stoves, matches, and even spontaneously from stored hay.





PROCTER CEMETERY PHASE III

The second part of Phase III of the Procter Cemetery Restoration is expected to restore fifty marble headstones that are dirty and


leaning at an estimated cost of \$23,000. Our Society currently has \$6,000 committed for the project thanks to our annual Calendar sales and Silent Auctions along with generous donations from the community and our members.

Members will survey the Cemetery this year to determine exactly which headstones are in most need of restoration. Fundraising efforts will continue with plans to apply for additional grants with a goal to complete this phase in 2026.

JOIN


It's time for our membership drive. Forms to renew or become a new member are available at the Library and online at RayLibrary.org/RayHistory. Annual membership levels start at just \$10.
