# PROCTER CEMETERY PHASE III


The second part of Phase III of the Procter Cemetery Restoration is expected to restore fifty marble headstones that are dirty and

leaning at an estimated cost of \$20,000. Our Society currently has \$6,000 committed for the project thanks to our annual Calendar sales and Silent Auctions along with generous donations from the community and our members.

Our goal is to survey the Cemetery this spring to determine exactly which headstones to restore then request updated cost estimates. Fundraising efforts will continue with plans to apply for additional grants.
