- He was enlisted into the army at the age of 44 Years old.
- Before he was enlisted he was a blacksmith
- When the War was over he was mustered out (discharged) in Nashville, Tennessee

Condition of the grave

Unique stuff about Isaiah

- Isaiah Briggs was in the military and served on the Union side of the war
- Isaiah survived the war
- He was born in New York, USA but was buried in Romeo, Macomb, County, Michigan
- Isaiah's grave is issued by the Government.
- Died on November 12, 1875
- He was enlisted on August 9, 1862 at Romeo for 3 years
- He died of old age and was 56-57
- He was buried in the romeo cemetery
- He was born in New york
