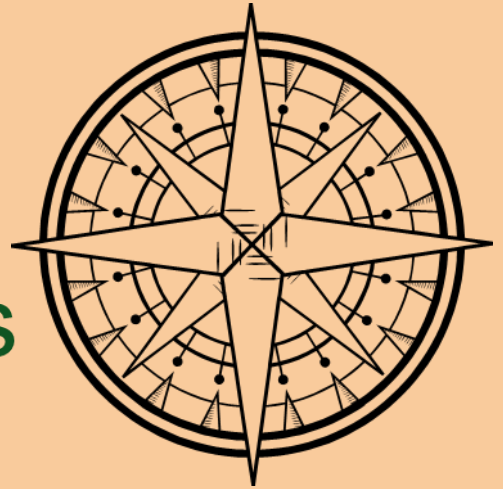


Civil War Soldier Project:

THOMAS C GIBSON

- DIED AT 70 YEARS OLD
- WAS BORN IN JUNE 28TH, 1831 (NY)
- ENLISTED FEB-5-1864
- HE DIED FROM EPILEPSY
- HE WAS FROM NEW YORK
- HE WAS LOCATED IN THE FIFTH MICHIGAN INFANTRY
- HE SERVED AT THE AGE 32 AT DETROIT
- HE WORKED IN DETROIT FOR 3 YEARS.
- HE SUPPORTED AS A SOLDIER FOR 20 YEARS.
- HIS RANK WAS PRIVATE

- HE SERVED IN THE INFANTRY, THE INFANTRY IS THE MAIN GROUND FORCE IT MEANS YOU FIGHT THE ENEMY ON LAND WITH A RIFLE.

- HE WAS EPILEPTIC

WHEN THOMAS C. GIBSON WAS BORN ON 28 JUNE 1831, IN NEW YORK, UNITED STATES, HIS FATHER, ALONZO GIBSON, WAS 25 AND HIS MOTHER, LUCY ANNE REID, WAS 23. HE LIVED IN BARRE, ORLEANS, NEW YORK, UNITED STATES FOR ABOUT 5 YEARS AND IMLAY TOWNSHIP, LAPEER, MICHIGAN, UNITED STATES IN 1880. HE DIED ON 21 APRIL 1902, IN TOWNSHIP OF RAY, MACOMB, MICHIGAN, UNITED STATES, AT THE AGE OF 70, AND WAS BURIED IN ROMEO, TOWNSHIP OF BRUCE, MACOMB, MICHIGAN, UNITED STATES.
