- He was about 75 years old when he died. He died on January 22nd, 1921 in the Michigan's soldiers home in Grand Rapids.
- He was 17 years old when he enlisted and served for about 2 years 1864 - 1866

## In The Civil War info:

He served the Union Illinois for 2 years as part of 49th regiment Illinois infantry his soldier's rank was sergeant. The infantry mostly attacks on foot to invade and hold territories.

Regiment lost 254 total soldiers during service.

Andrew Hicks was born in New York and died in Grand Rapids. He had one daughter, Mable Menzie, who was born in 1861 and died in Kalamazoo in 1949. He married a woman whose first name is unknown but maiden name is Fuller. In his later life he suffered from urinary diseases. He also suffered from chronic diarrhea for 25 years.
