

Caleb Sidney Hicks

Caleb Hicks died in **March 1, 1923** after being over 80 years old. And he suffered from **chronic diarrhea** and **dyspepsia** as a result of service in the civil war. He was buried at the **romeo cemetery**.

Caleb Hicks was buried on August 4, 1923 **156 days after he died**.



Caleb Hicks was a **white male** who was **married to Martha Hicks** and lived in **Romeo Michigan**. He is from **Wayne county, New York** and moved to Michigan

Before the war, Caleb Hicks was one of the **nine founders** of the **First Baptist Church of Lapeer, Michigan**, in **1858**.

He **enlisted on August 6, 1861**, and was **discharged for disability on May 23, 1862**.



He was 19 years old when he first enlisted

He was from New York

His father was Leonard Hicks, his mother was Mary Whitcomb

He had chronic diarrhea and dyspepsia caused by the war.

His rank in the military was private, meaning he was the lowest rank.
