Hood's attack on Murfreesboro December 5-12, 1864. Moved to Huntsville ,Ala on January 16, 1865. Hood's attack was a failed Confederate attempt to destroy Union supply lines.

Life story

Emmett was born October 31, 1845 in Bruce, Macomb, Michigan. His father Orman was 28, Matilda, his mother, was 25. He married Sarah, April 28, 1870 in Addison Township. He lived in Macomb in 1890 and romeo in 1900's. He registered for military service in 1847. He died January 14, 1914 in macomb at the age of 68.

How did he serve?

He traveled back and forth from Tennessee and Alabama in battles. He was a part of a significant battle Defending Decatur, Ala against hoods attack in 1864. He was discharged in Detroit MI, 1866.

He was a retired Undertaker.

He died of heart disease but it was not caused by the war.

Siblings?

He is a twin to Merrett Hopkins.

Parents?

His dads name is Orman W Hopkins. Born in middleton, Wyoming. Lifespan 1817-1898.

His moms name is Matilda Turrell. Born in Rush, Monroe. Lifespan 1820-1904.

He had a wife named Sarah Ann Beach. Born in Michigan. Lifespan 1850-1925.
