




Here are some suggestions for use:

- ✓ Print, laminate and cut out the color cards (pages 3&4). Place them in your science center and have students use the “Life Cycle Order” printable (page 7) to practice placing the cards in the correct order.
- ✓ Print the black & white cards (pages 5&6) for students to color. Have them cut out the cards and glue them in the correct order on their own “Life Cycle Order” printable (page 7).
- ✓ Use the “Life Cycle Order” printable (page 7) to have students draw and label each stage of the butterfly or frog life cycle.
- ✓ We have provided a draw and write for the butterfly and frog life cycles (pages 8&9). Students can write about the stages in the life cycles using “first, next, then, and last”.
