How and when he died?

- HE DIED WHEN HE WAS 83 YEARS OLD ON MAY 10, 1910
- HE SUFFERED FROM CHRONIC DIARRHEA AND PILES AND INDLAMMAORY RHEUMAISM AS A RESULT OF SERVICE IN THE CIVIL WAR
- PREDMORE, JEDUTHAN ENLISTED WHEN HE WAS 34 YEARS OLD IN AUGUST 21, 1861

- BORN IN NEW JERSEY ON AUGUST 27TH
- SON OF JOSHUA AND JEMIMA
- HE LIVED IN BRANDON
- WAS A CLERK BY TRADE

JEDUTHAN SERVED IN THE FIRST MICHIGAN CAVALRY AND WAS DISCHARGED AT HIS EXPIRATION OF TERM OF SERVICE IN 1864.



FIRST MICHIGAN CAVALRY.

THE FIRST MICHIGAN CAVALRY (DURING THE TIME JEDUTHAN SERVED) FOUGHT IN THE BATTLE OF WINCHESTER, BATTLE OF CEDAR MOUNTAIN, BATTLE OF SECOND BULL RUN, AND EVEN THE BATTLE OF GETTYSBURG. THEY WERE PART OF THE UNION.

JEDUTHAN'S ENLISTMENT WAS PRIVATE, THE LOWEST RANK MEANING HE WAS MOST LIKELY A JUNIOR SERVICE MEMBER.
