MSU Extension now has a completely online, self-paced, introductory course on Smart Gardening with Vegetables. Learn how you can contribute to the Smart Gardening principles of creating healthy soils and plants, while enjoying the health benefits of growing and eating fresh produce.

In this course, MSU Extension Consumer Horticulture educators, Rebecca Krans and Sarah Rautio, cover gardening from start to finish with 6 lessons:

Many resources are available to download onto your own computer. Participants work at their own pace and have 90 days to complete the course.
